Thank you for participating in the main Pathfinder fundraiser for the year. Please see below for the time and duty your family has been allocated (see following pages for description of duty, which are as per Bunnings requirements). We only need one parent from each family. If you are unable to participate in your allocated time slot – please swap / change with someone and advise Priscilla. If you cannot attend on the day, please contact Priscilla ASAP on 0412 082 200.

This fundraising event requires the assistance of parents as children under the age of 18 are not allowed to volunteer as per Bunnings rules. Bunnings also requires that all volunteers wear their own clean cloth apron, which cannot be shared. We will have some available, but if you can bring your own that would be helpful.

Attire

- Enclosed Shoes must be worn.
- No singlets - must wear a t-shirt. If you have a Pathfinder polo (or fit into your child's one) please wear it.
- Hair must be tied back

On the day

- **Meet near the main entrance to Bunnings 5 mins before your allocated time slot.** Pathfinder Leaders will be available all day and will meet you there.
- All people handling food must wear food handling gloves and an apron.

BBQ Captain / ORDER - The BBQ Captain is the key volunteer for the group to ensure the fundraiser runs smoothly and is successful.

The responsibilities of the BBQ Captain include:

- Register to use Bunnings free Mobile Payments if their community group is using the offer
- Be on site at all times throughout the BBQ
- Ensure volunteers immediately report to the BBQ Captain and are feeling well.
- Adhere to and complete the BBQ clean 3 times a day
- Complete reporting of expenses and fundraising total at the end of the day.
- Must wear clean clothes and a clean, individual-use apron. compulsory
- Take orders and accept payment by cash
- If a drink is ordered, the preferred drink is collected from the esky and placed on the table for the customer

COOK

- Not attend the sausage sizzle if they are unwell or have any cold or flu like symptoms
- Must wear clean clothes and cloth apron not worn by any other volunteer that day
- The cook is only required to wear gloves when handling raw food. If the cook is using tongs for cooking, then the use of gloves is optional.
- Cook sausages and onions
- Cooked sausages and onions are placed in foil trays on the wire frame above hotplate to keep warm
- Places the sausage/onion on bread provided by the 'Collect' group member
- Standard rules around food safety – all food to remain covered except when cooking.

COLLECT

- Not attend the sausage sizzle if they are unwell or have any cold or flu-like symptoms.
- Must wear clean clothes and clean, individual-use apron - compulsory
- Collects bread and napkin from supplies table, and sausage/onion from the Cook
- Place sausages on sausage holder at Collect table i.e. does not place directly into customer hand
- Customer takes sausage from holder
