Dear parents and Pathfinders,

Get ready for the biggest Pathfinder event in Australia! Join thousands of Pathfinders from across the country at Trusted Camporee 2027.

Experience inspiring worship, exciting activities, lifelong friendships, and unforgettable memories as we look at the life of Abraham and discover what it means to be Trusted.

What is a Pathfinder Camporee?

Camporee is a regional gathering of Pathfinders for a period of camping and common activities, and they are the biggest events of interaction between Pathfinder clubs around the world. The Australian Union Conference (AUC) Pathfinder Camporee is held every 4 years. Pathfinders from all over Australia come to play, share, learn and worship together.

This Camporee promises to be an unforgettable five days. There will be exciting new activities, new friendship opportunities, top speakers, outstanding night programs with awesome music and drama — and all for the express purpose of sharing Jesus and leading kids into committed decisions to follow God. With all of this in mind, we would love to invite your Pathfinders to come along and be a part of the Trusted Camporee.

Location: Camporee will be held near Ipswich, QLD, at [Ivorys Rock Events and Camping Centre](#). Ivorys Rock offers outstanding facilities in a beautiful nature setting.

Brief preliminary information to allow for planning purposes:

- Provisional dates will be from 3 to 13 January. This is to allow travel with an overnight stop there and back and the possibility of some extra activities after Camporee.
- Travel – there is a possibility that we will be sharing a coach with another club. Alternatively it will be as per usual camps, with leaders in their cars.
- All meals will be catered for by our wonderful Castle Hill club volunteer cooks – you do not need to bring any food. All allergies will be catered for.
- You will need to bring all your sleeping gear – we will send out a comprehensive list closer to the date. You will be sleeping in tents as normal.

Costs per Pathfinder:

1. AUC Camporee fee (**\$285**) - to get the early bird rate of \$285 the fee must be paid by 3 September 2026. See below for the unique link that must be used to register with our club.
2. CHP club fee - this will be between **\$150 - \$180** and is dependent on fundraising efforts. This fee will be paid later in the year and covers food, transport, accommodation while travelling to/from Camporee, trading pins, Castle Hill camporee t-shirt etc.

We recognise this is a substantial cost, particularly for those families with multiple Pathfinders. We have done our best to reduce costs as far as we are able. However, feel free to talk to us if these costs are still too high. You must contact us before registering with the AUC website link and no later than 20 August 2026.

We encourage everyone to attend this event, as it is an amazing experience and something the Pathfinders will remember forever.
